#### AT MARIE SANDVIK CENTER:

**Linens:** Quilts and sheets for all bed sizes, pillowcases, blankets, bath towels, dish towels and table cloths

**Baby Layette Items:** New or gently used baby shirts, cloth and disposable, diapers, pins, plastic pants, bottles, sleepers, outer garments, quilts, toilet articles, receiving blankets, booties and sweaters

**Housewares:** Pots & pans, silverware, dishes, glasses, cups, can openers and cooking utensils

**Food & non-food items:** Canned goods – soups, fruit, vegetables, peanut butter, jelly, meat, sugar, coffee, flour, cake mixes, cookies, eggs, dish soap, powdered laundry detergent, toilet paper, soap and Similac baby formula, feminine care products, diapers (all sizes) and baby wipes

### BABY CARE KIT:

*New or gently used – 6 - 24 month size*

<i>2 T-shirt, cotton - no onesies</i>	<i>1 sweater w/ cap or</i>
<i>2 gowns or sleepers, w/o feet</i>	<i>sweatshirt w/ hood</i>
<i>2 receiving blankets</i>	<i>2 bath-size bars of soap - gentle</i>
<i>4 cloth diapers</i>	<i>2 diaper pins</i>
<i>1 hand towel, dark color</i>	<i>2 pair of socks</i>

Cut 2- 45" square of flannel fabric to make a blanket. Diapers can be made by using a pinking shear to cut pieces 22 ½" x 36". Wrap items in one of the receiving blankets and secure with diaper pins.

### FABRIC KIT:

*2 pieces of cotton or cotton blend fabric; each piece should match one of the sizes below: (no knits or 100 % polyester)*

*2 ¼ yds 60" wide fabric or,  
3 yds 44" wide fabric or,  
4 yds 36" fabric  
2 spools matching thread*

Wrap sewing notions inside fabric and tie with a string yarn or a strip of fabric.

### SCHOOL KIT:

<i>4-70 ruled sheet notebooks (8 1/2" x 11")</i>	<i>1-30 centimeter ruler</i>
<i>1 box 16 or 24 crayons</i>	<i>5 unsharpened pencils w/ erasers secured w/ rubber band</i>
<i>1 blunt safety scissors</i>	<i>5 ballpoint pens (blue or black) secured w/ rubber band</i>
<i>1 pencil sharpener</i>	
<i>1 drawstring backpack bag</i>	
<i>1- 2 ½" eraser</i>	

Pack items in the bag, fold handles over and secure w/ two large rubber bands or tie with yarn.

### PERSONAL CARE KIT:

<i>1 bath towel, dark color (20x40)</i>	<i>1 toothbrush</i>
<i>1 metal nail file or nail clipper</i>	<i>1 wide-tooth comb</i>
<i>2 bath-size bars of soap (4-5 oz)</i>	<i>(no bulk soap)</i>

Wrap in a towel and tie securely with ribbon or yarn.

## **GUIDELINES FOR SERVING FUNERALS TO OUR REDEEMER’S CHURCH MEMBERS AND NON-MEMBERS**

For members of Our Redeemer’s Lutheran Church, there are no charges for the use of the Church building, but both members and non-members pay a custodial fee of \$50. There is also a \$75 fee for the usage of the Fellowship Hall Kitchen and if you are in need of dishwashers or coffee makers there is an extra \$25 fee for each. For non-members there are various fees for the use of the Church building, along with the \$50 custodial fee. Fees are listed on the form. Individuals scheduling an event must fill out a **Request of Usage Form**.

### Our Redeemer’s Women Luncheon Policy

- The suggested contribution to the Our Redeemer’s Women for providing meal: \$4.00 per plate. See policy below:
- No group larger than 35 will be served in the Fellowship Café. Meals will consist of buns with meat, pickles and cake. Groups of 35 or more must be served in the Fellowship Hall.
- Any foods other than those named above must be provided by the family, either brought in or ordered from a caterer at their expense. ORW will serve, but will not order or pick up such items.
- The **funeral lunch** menu consists of: buns with ham, cake, pickles, water and coffee with condiments. It will be served by a Work Unit of the ORW to the bereaved family mourners.

### Guidelines for use of Fellowship Hall Kitchen

For individuals wishing to use the Fellowship Hall Kitchen a **Request of Usage Form** needs to be completed. The form is available in the church office. The fee/s includes using either space for a wedding, anniversary, shower, graduation, confirmation or any other function of private or of public nature. The check is made payable to Our Redeemer’s Lutheran Church. It includes the use of all dishes, silverware, coffeepots, electric roasters, towels, silver service set and punch bowl.

At the conclusion of using the Fellowship Hall Kitchen and/or the Fellowship Café/Kitchenette as well as any other area, the site shall be left in a clean, tidy and in orderly manner.
